Jayvee Nine Shows Improvement

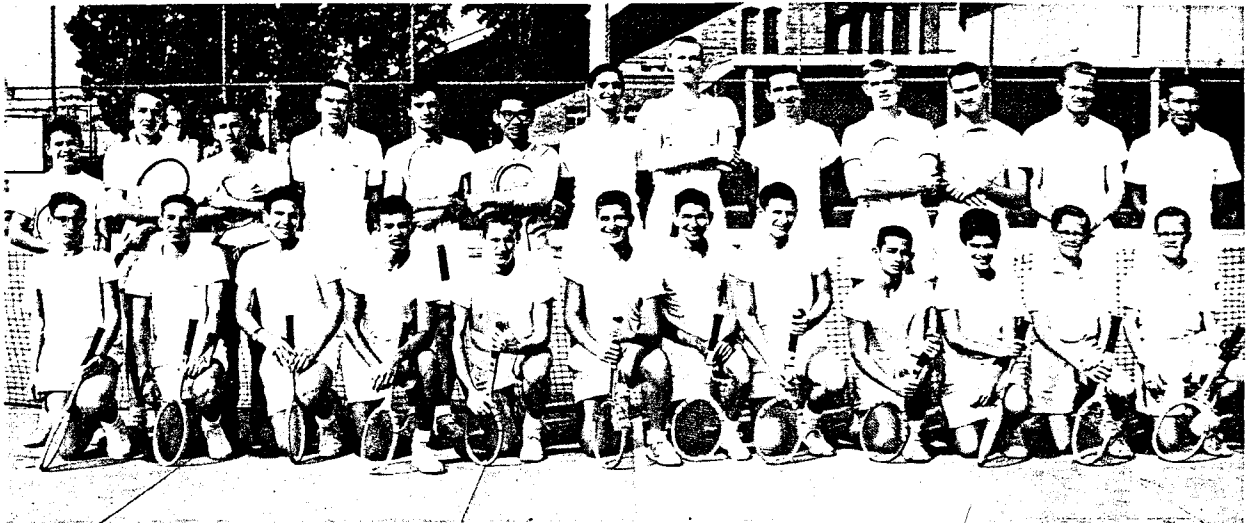
